The City of Howell has received a grant to investigate our sanitary sewer and storm sewer systems. As part of that grant, the City of Howell will be performing inspections on our sanitary and storm sewer manholes. Starting in Summer of 2018, field technicians from our consultant, Hubbell, Roth, and Clark, Inc. (HRC), will be locating and inspecting manhole structures. As some of these structures are located in side and rear yards, crews may be working in the easements located on your property to access these structures. All technicians will have appropriate identification badges. Any areas disturbed for this work will be restored. It is not the intention to bring any equipment into yards or perform any construction at this time.
